CODE OF BEHAVIOR

Welcome to the Quo Vadis Retreat! We are glad that you will be sharing this experience with us. We know that you will represent yourself well during this Retreat.

We want you to know what our expectations are for you during the Quo Vadis Retreat. Please read these items over carefully. We believe that these rules will ensure that the Quo Vadis Retreat experience will be enjoyable and profitable for all. Please note that all participants of the retreat will be expected to live by these regulations.

Some Rules:

1. We look to the adult leaders in each group to help implement this code of behavior. Please respect these adults as they fulfill their role.
2. Participants are expected to attend all activities designated by the Vocation Office on this retreat.
3. All participants must stay in their respective rooms during the hours assigned for sleep.
4. The purchase, possession, or consumption of any alcoholic beverage and the possession or use of any illegal drugs by any individual will not be tolerated. No sexual activity or conversation, which can include inappropriate comments, gestures, comments, or images, will be tolerated. Any infraction of these rules will mean immediate dismissal from the Quo Vadis Retreat event at parents' or guardians' expense.
5. Whenever the schedule calls for small group activities, each participant must be with the leader(s) and members of his group. No one may leave the grounds of Anna Maria College, Paxton MA, without permission.
6. All participants will be expected to observe the rules of Anna Maria College and any other venue visited over the course of the retreat.
7. Any use of technology, e.g. phones and tablets, can only be used with permission or for emergency use.
8. In the unlikely event that a behavior problem, based on the above, requires extreme action, it is likely that immediate dismissal from the program will result.
9. Smoking or Vaping will not be allowed by anyone on the Quo Vadis Retreat.

I understand and agree to abide by the Quo Vadis Retreat Code of Behavior. I also understand and agree that I will notify my parent(s) or guardian(s) at the time of any infractions requiring my dismissal from the Quo Vadis Retreat. In that circumstance, I understand and agree that I will be sent home at my own or my parents' or my guardians' expense.
